## **CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES**

DATES OF OBSTRUCTION: **9/17/2020 to 10/29/2020**

TIME OF OBSTRUCTION: **Daylight hours 07:00 to 18:00**

DURATION OF CRANE USAGE: **Each day, this crane will be in use at random lift times during daylight hours.**

LOCATION OF OBSTRUCTION: **5800 Block of Park Avenue Richmond, VA**

DISTANCE FROM HELIPAD (feet): **approx. 500**

DIRECTION FROM HELIPAD (West, East, North, South): **SOUTH**

A Crane will be erected in the vicinity of the St. Mary’s Hospital Helipad south of **Park Avenue between Libbie Avenue & Maple Avenue on the Westhampton School site.**

The Crane will be approximately **500 FEET South of the St. Mary’s Hospital Helipad.**

Crane Heights: **220** feet above ground level (AGL) at max height; **321** feet above mean sea level (AMSL)

- THE HELIPAD IS 245 FEET AMSL.
- The Crane’s maximum height during the working day is **218** feet **ABOVE** the Helipad.

### **CRANE OBSTRUCTION MARKINGS:**

- DAYLIGHT HOURS:  
An obstruction flag will be in place at the top of boom.
- SUNSET TO SUNRISE:  
At night, the crane boom will be boomed down to an elevation of 68’ AGL (321’ AMSL) and will be lit with one warning light at top of boom elevation.
